Zinc deficiency leads to over 450,000 child deaths each year.

THE FACTS:

- Zinc is required by the body in order for life to thrive
- 1/3 of the world population is at risk of zinc deficiency
- Zinc deficiency is one of the major factors involved with diarrhea, pneumonia and malaria which leads to high mortality rates in many countries around the world
- Zinc deficiency especially impacts children under five years of age
- Zinc deficiency can be eradicated

ZINC IS ESSENTIAL

Zinc is an essential micro-nutrient for human health. It activates cell division, growth, physical and brain development and protects the body from diseases. Zinc also strengthens the immune system and helps fight infections.

Zinc is supplied to the body through a diversified diet. However, **close to 2-billion people worldwide are at risk of not getting enough zinc through their diets.** Children under five years of age are most affected. Zinc deficiency weakens their immune system and leaves them vulnerable to diarrhea and infectious diseases such as pneumonia and malaria. Zinc deficiency also leads to growth retardation and stunting and impedes intellectual development preventing children from developing to their full potential.

ZINC SAVES LIVES

Zinc ranks high on the list of child survival interventions. Zinc is particularly effective in treating diarrhea which kills 1.5 million children every year.

In 2008, the Copenhagen Consensus, a panel of eight leading economists, concluded that combating malnutrition in undernourished children by providing vitamin A and zinc is the most cost-effective solution to the world's leading challenges.

The Zinc Saves Kids® initiative is helping to send zinc supplements to where they are needed most.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

It takes little to save a child's life:

- .50 cents for a 10-14 day course of zinc tablets can treat acute diarrhea.
